Welcome to the 2009 Olivet College Lou Collins Memorial Tournament!

TOURNAMENT HISTORY

In 1996, there was a goal to establish a highly respected small college men's golf tournament that would be hosted by a NCAA Division III college in Michigan. The NCAA Division III Great Lakes Region is made up of the states of Indiana, Michigan and Ohio. Michigan was the only state that did not host a Division III tournament. From this, the Olivet College Comet Classic was born. In 2006, the classic was renamed in honor of Lou Collins, and beginning this year, the tournament will be in memory of Collins, who passed away Sept. 2. Collins was a long-time supporter of the Olivet golf program.

There will be 12 teams vying for the championship this year. The tournament field is made up of one school from Indiana, one school from Ohio and nine from Michigan. Seven of the teams are NCAA Division III affiliates, four are members of the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics and one is a junior college.

TRIVIA AND UNIQUE HAPPENINGS

- In 1998, the Classic was played at two different golf courses but on the same 18 holes. The tournament started at the Wishbone Glen Course. Having been sold, the facility was renamed that day and everyone noticed the new sign, "The Medalist" as they drove out of the gate.
- During the 2002 Classic, Craig Eckerle of Denison (Ohio) University scored a hole in one on the 15th hole.
- In the 2003 Classic, Hope and Olivet colleges tied for first-place. Hope was awarded the championship because of its lower fifth-man score. In addition, Olivet's Michael Dinner set a tournament record with a 141 two-round score.
- In 2006, Bethel (Ind.) College and Davenport University tied for first-place with a 610 team score. Bethel was declared the team champion with a lower fifth-man score. Last year, the host Comets won the tournament for the second straight year with a tournament record 588 team score.
- Last year, Warner Southern College was the first school from Florida to participate in the tournament.

ABOUT BEDFORD VALLEY COUNTRY CLUB

Bedford Valley Country Club has been labeled "The Big Course" by many who have played on it. One of 163 golf courses designed by William Mitchell, Bedford Valley plays almost like two different courses. The front nine goes up-and-down the hills of the southwest Michigan landscape. The back nine has the players facing huge tree-lined fairways throughout the finishing holes.

Each green has strategically-placed sand traps that can catch any off-line shot and escalate scores quickly. The greens are large enough to invite long second shots but pin placement can create a real hazard of three putts. Water comes into play on four holes. The sand and up-and-down layout provides a major challenge for even the best golfers.
