## CAMP DESCRIPTION

The camp is recreational-based with an equal emphasis on learning the fundamentals of soccer and enjoying the game. There will be an excellent instructor-to-camper ratio, which insures that all campers receive individualized attention.

## STAFF

The camp is directed by Hans Morgan, Olivet College's head women's soccer coach. His extensive coaching experience includes work with the men's soccer program at Western Michigan University, the women's soccer program at Eastern Michigan University, high schools and the TKO and Michigan Wolves programs. Morgan also holds a national coaching license from the United States Soccer Foundation.

The rest of the camp staff consists of coaches and players from the Olivet men's and women's soccer programs.
