DIRECTIONS TO OLIVET COLLEGE

From Detroit (South): Take I-94 west to I-69 north. Follow I-69 north to exit 48. From the exit ramp turn right. Proceed until you reach the stop sign at Main Street, about 1 mile. Keep going straight at the stop sign and the entrance to the athletic facility is on your right.

From Detroit (North): Take I-696 west to I-96 west to I-69 south. Follow I-69 south to exit 48. From the exit ramp turn left. Proceed until you reach the stop sign at Main Street, about 1 mile. Keep going straight at the stop sign and the entrance to the athletic facility is on your right.

From Lansing: Take I-69 south to exit 48. From the exit ramp turn left. Proceed until you reach the stop sign at Main Street, about 1 mile. Keep going straight at the stop sign and the entrance to the athletic facility is on your right.

From Chicago/Kalamazoo: Take I-94 east to I-69 north. Follow I-69 north to exit 48. From the exit ramp turn right. Proceed until you reach the stop sign at Main Street, about 1 mile. Keep going straight at the stop sign and the entrance to the athletic facility is on your right.

From Mount Pleasant: Take 127 south to I-69 west/south. Follow I-69 south to exit 48. From the exit ramp turn left. Proceed until you reach the stop sign at Main Street, about 1 mile. Keep going straight at the stop sign and the entrance to the athletic facility is on your right.

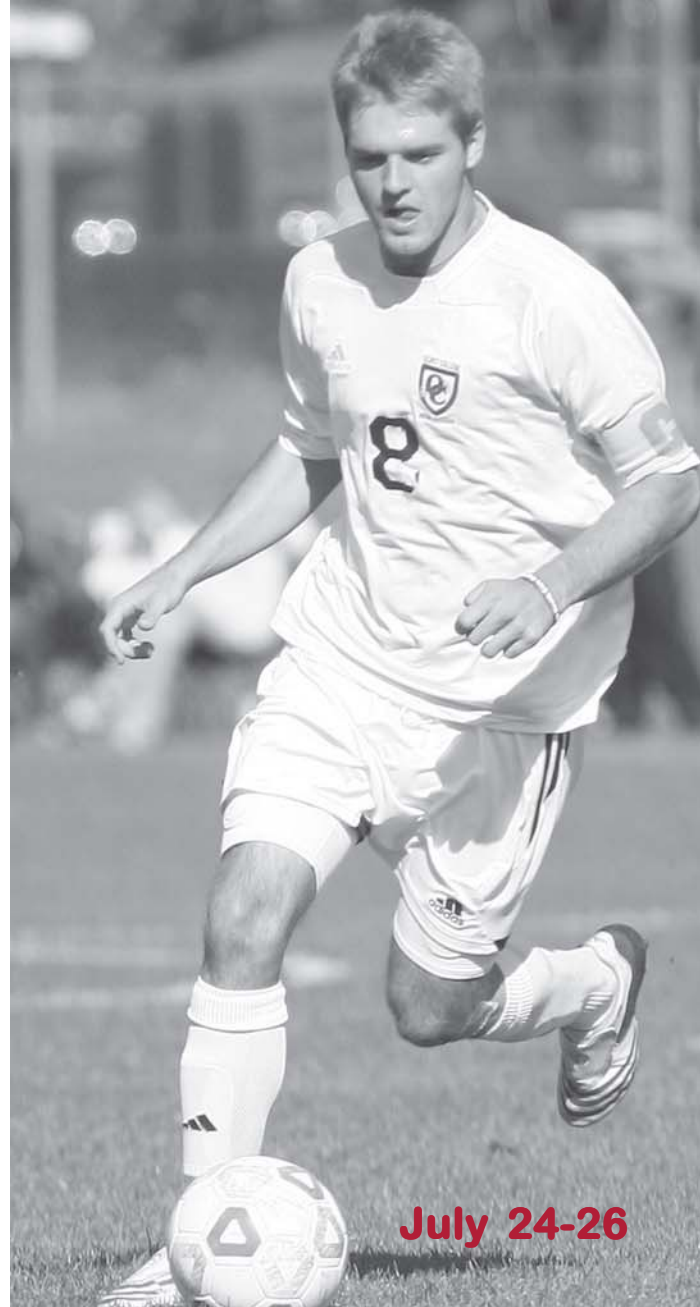

WELCOME

The Olivet College *2009 Boys' Soccer Team Camp* is designed to help prepare high school varsity teams for a successful season. Teams are guaranteed at least five full 11 vs. 11 games. Each team will play at least one game on the college's beautiful game field and one game on the college's artificial turf football field. Coaches are encouraged to attend the camp. In addition, all campers will receive a one-hour speed training session with Mike Sparks, Olivet's strength and conditioning coach. Participants will also have access to the campus weight training room and swimming pool.

This competitive team camp is a great way to kick off your season, as it occurs just two weeks before teams can begin official practice. Campers will spend their time playing soccer against live competition rather than listening to lectures or running drills. The ability to have the high school coaching staff available to view, coach and interact with the team at the camp is an additional bonus. Teams will also be given a chance to have one session run by a member of the Comet coaching staff.

CAMP DIRECTOR: HANS MORGAN

The team camp is run by Olivet College Head Women's Soccer Coach Hans Morgan.

Morgan is excited to share his knowledge and passion for soccer with you. His extensive coaching experience includes work with the men's soccer program at Western Michigan University, the women's soccer program at Eastern Michigan University, high schools and the TKO and Michigan Wolves programs. Morgan also holds a national coaching license from the United States Soccer Foundation.

"The Olivet Team Camp allows our team to come together a few weeks early and play five competitive matches in a weekend. The opportunity really gives us a jump-start through tryouts and into the beginning of the season. COST AND OTHER INFORMATION

The cost of the camp is \$190 per person. Full payment is required with your registration.

Each team must have a minimum of 15 players (maximum of 25 players). Each individual player registration form must be signed by parent/guardian, collected and sent together as a team. Each team is required to have two adult chaperones attend the camp and serve in a supervisory capacity from 9 p.m. to 8 a.m. These chaperones will attend the camp free of charge.

Additional chaperones are charged for room and board only. Commuters are also accepted in this camp, and their cost is \$95, which includes meals.

When two or more family members participate, there is a \$25 discount per camper.

The cost of the camp has been reduced this year due to the state of the U.S. economy.
