DIRECTIONS TO OLIVET COLLEGE

From Detroit (South): Take I-94 west to I-69 north. Follow I-69 north to exit 48. From the exit ramp turn right. Proceed until you reach the stop sign at Main St. and go straight. The entrance to The Cutler Event Center is on your right.

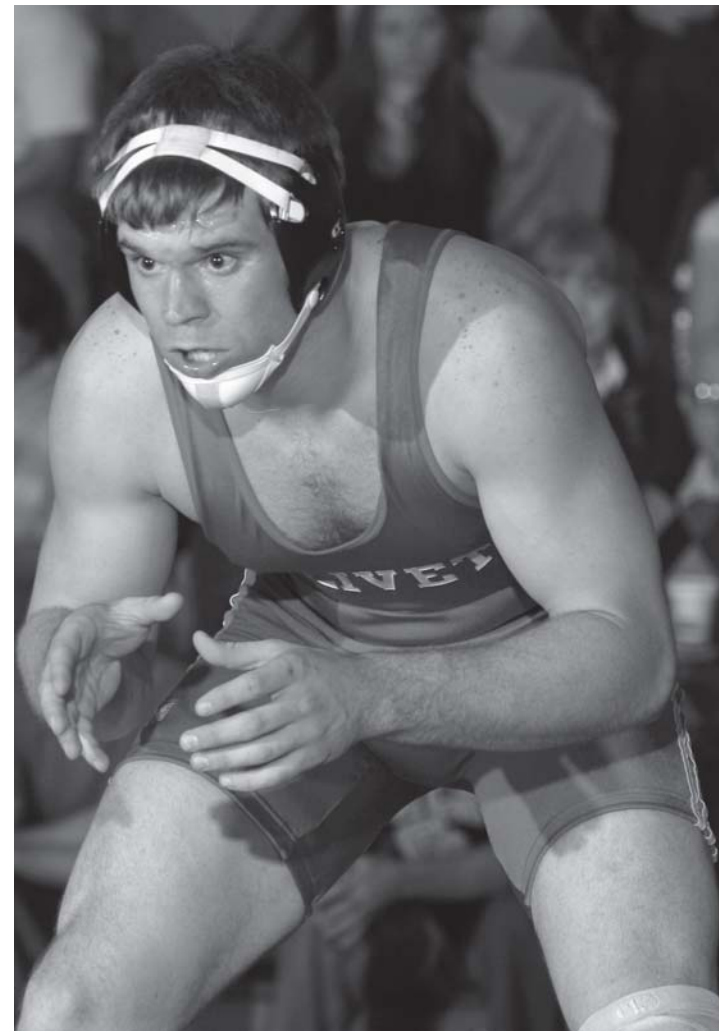

WELCOME

The Olivet College Wrestling Camp is broken down into two segments. The first segment is a Youth Camp for elementary and beginning middle schools wrestlers. The second segment is the Traditional Camp for advanced middle school and all high school wrestlers.

The camp is designed to allow participants to learn the value of all that is important in the development of a student-athlete. While the traditional subjects of wrestling training and solid technique are covered daily and in-depth by our experienced staff, we are also interested in the *complete wrestler*. Along these lines, we put an emphasis on evening discussions about academics, commitment, integrity and the psychology of the sport. We keep it simple for the youth in our camp, but we believe that these areas of concentration are critical to becoming a champion in wrestling and in life, and we will not overlook them.

Each day, campers will interact with outstanding coaches and role models from all levels of wrestling: elementary, middle school, high school and college. We will cover takedowns in all aspects, from set-up to finish, as well as aggressive mat wrestling and attitudes and styles in training to be a champion. This is a comprehensive camp, one which will allow the development of young wrestlers in terms of character, work ethic and wrestling ability.

CAMP DIRECTOR: TODD HIBBS

The wrestling camp is supervised by Olivet College Head Wrestling Coach Todd Hibbs.

Hibbs' long résumé of success and passion in the sport is matched by his tenure in the helping youth. While also serving as a wrestling coach at different levels over the past two decades, he also has extensive experience serving youth populations. Hibbs' education in psychology (particularly with youth and adolescents) and background of many years in the field of alcohol and drug prevention lend him a unique perspective in camp work.

In wrestling circles, Hibbs is known for his successes as both a student-athlete and coach. As a competitor, he was a scholastic All-Ohio performer and a two-time NCAA Division III All-American, as well as a two-time Scholar All-American at Mount Union (Ohio) College. As a coach, Hibbs had success at the high school level in Ohio before moving on to take the reigns of the Olivet College program. Since arriving at Olivet, his teams have gained national recognition by consistently being ranked among the best in the nation athletically and academically.

In just his second year, Hibbs was named the NCAA Midwest Regional Coach of the Year and was a finalist for the National Coach of the Year.

COST AND OTHER INFORMATION

The Olivet College Wrestling Camp prides itself on providing a quality service at one of the more economically sound rates in the entire Midwest. The cost for the Youth Camp is \$150 for a residential camper, while the commuter cost is \$100. The cost for the Traditional Camp is \$260 for a residential camper, while the commuter cost is \$130. Residential campers must be entering the fourth grade in Fall 2009.

Included in these fees for residents are room and dinner costs, while also included for both residents and commuters are lunch, facility usage, T-shirt and instructional fees.

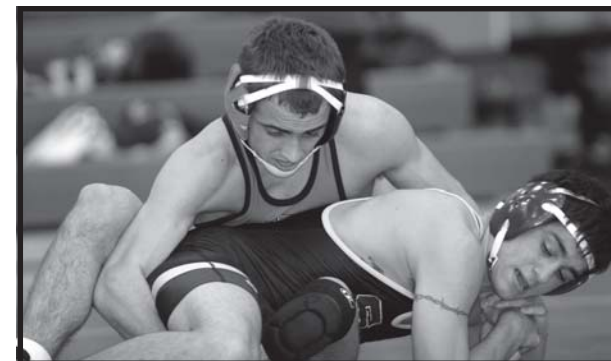
