


Dear Parents,

DIRECTIONS TO OLIVET

From Detroit (south): Take I-94 west to I-69 north. Follow I-69 north to exit 48. From the exit ramp turn right. Proceed until you reach the stop sign at Main St. and go straight. The entrance to The Cutler Event Center is on your right.

From Detroit (north): Take I-696 west to I-96 west to I-69 south. Follow I-69 south to exit 48. From the exit ramp turn left. Proceed until you reach the stop sign at Main St. and go straight. The entrance to The Cutler Event Center is on your right.

From Lansing: Take I-69 south to Exit 48. From the exit ramp turn left. Proceed until you reach the stop sign at Main St. and go straight. The entrance to The Cutler Event Center is on your right.

From Chicago/Kalamazoo: Take I-94 east to I-69 north. Follow I-69 north to exit 48. From the exit ramp turn right. Proceed until you reach the stop sign at Main St. and go straight. The entrance to The Cutler Event Center is on your right.

From Mount Pleasant: Take 127 south to I-69 west/south. Follow I-69 south to exit 48. From the exit ramp turn left. Proceed until you reach the stop sign at Main St. and go straight. The entrance to The Cutler Event Center is on your right.
