Olivet was one of the first institutions in America to admit women and minorities. ## HOME EVENT INFORMATION

### BASEBALL AND SOFTBALL

Games are played on the fields located behind The Cutler Event Center. The visiting team uses the first base dugout. Locker rooms are located inside The Cutler Event Center.

### BASKETBALL

Games are played on Hathaway Court inside The Cutler Event Center. The visiting team uses the team area at the west end, where Olivet is painted on the baseline. Locker rooms are located inside the facility.

### FOOTBALL

Games are played on the field at the Cutler Athletic Complex. There are locker rooms inside The Cutler Event Center.

### GOLF

The home course for men's golf is Bedford Valley Country Club, 23161 Waubascon Rd., which is a couple turns off M-66 in Battle Creek. The home course for women's golf is The Medalist Golf Club, 15701 N Drive North, which is just off I-69 in Marshall.

### SOCCER

Games are played on the field located behind The Cutler Event Center. The visiting team bench is at the south end of the field. There are locker rooms inside The Cutler Event Center.

### SWIMMING AND DIVING

Swimming and diving meets are held in the Upton Center pool. There are locker rooms adjacent to the pool.

### TENNIS

Matches are played at the Michigan State University Indoor Tennis Facility, 3571 E. Mt. Hope Ave., which is off Harrison Road in East Lansing.

### TRACK AND FIELD

Track and field meets are held at the Cutler Athletic Complex. The track is around the perimeter of the football field, while field events will be contested in other areas within the Cutler Athletic Complex.

### VOLLEYBALL

Matches are played on Hathaway Court inside The Cutler Event Center. The visiting team uses the bench at the west end, where Olivet is painted on the floor. Locker rooms are located inside the facility.

### WRESTLING

Duals are held in The Cutler Event Center. There are locker rooms inside the facility.

## ADMISSIONS POLICY

Olivet College has a \$5 admission charge per person for all home regular season volleyball, football, basketball (men's and women's) and wrestling contests. Students from MIAA schools are free with ID. The admission charge for MIAA and NCAA championship contests may be different.

## VAN/BUS PARKING INFORMATION

For all athletic events, except football and swimming and diving, visiting team vans or buses must park in the parking lot beside the Cutler Athletic Complex.

For football, the visiting team buses must park in the grass lot across from the football field. The entire paved parking lot in front and beside the Cutler Athletic Complex is pass only. Fans are asked to park in the grass lot across from the football field.

For swimming and diving, visiting team vans or buses may be parked on any street surrounding the Upton Center or in the parking lot behind the center.

## ATHLETIC TRAINING INFORMATION

When your team visits, the Olivet College athletic training staff will provide the following:

- 1) Staff athletic trainer at every contest
- 2) Team physician at all home varsity football games and on-call at all other contests
- 3) Water, ice, cups and ice bags
- 4) Service for teams visiting without an athletic trainer. We do ask that you provide tape and any other necessary materials.

Olivet College athletic training operates out of the athletic training room in the Cutler Athletic Complex. A variety of modalities, including ice packs, hydrocollator packs, electrical stimulation and ultrasound are available to the visiting teams. If visiting athletes require an electrical stimulation or ultrasound treatment prior to a contest, please provide written instructions and parameters for application from a certified athletic trainer or physician. If an athletic training student is accompanying the team, a written note from the supervising certified athletic trainer or physician is also required.

Olivet College utilizes two area hospitals that are approximately 15 minutes from the college. Directions can be provided upon request.

# DIRECTIONS TO OLIVET COLLEGE

Olivet College is located in south central Michigan, 30 miles southwest of Lansing, the state capital, and 125 miles west of Detroit.

**From Detroit (South):** Take I-94 west to I-69 north. Follow I-69 north to exit 48. From the exit ramp turn right. Proceed until you reach the stop sign at Main St., about 1 mile. If you are coming for an outdoor sport, go straight at the stop sign. Proceed about 1/4 mile, turn right into the Cutler Athletic Complex parking lot. If you are coming for swimming and diving, turn left at the stop sign. Proceed and turn right onto Cottage St. (about 1/2 mile). The Upton Center Pool is located 1/4 mile on the right side.

**From Detroit (North):** Take I-696 west to I-96 west to I-69 south. Follow I-69 south to exit 51 (Ainger Road). From the exit ramp turn left. Proceed until you reach the stop sign at Main St., about 1 mile. Turn right at the stop sign. If you are coming for a swimming and diving meet, turn left at Cottage St. (about 1/2 mile) and the Upton Center Pool is 1/4 mile on your right side. If you are coming for an outdoor sport, continue on Main St. and turn left onto Butterfield Hwy. and make a right turn into the Cutler Athletic Complex parking lot.

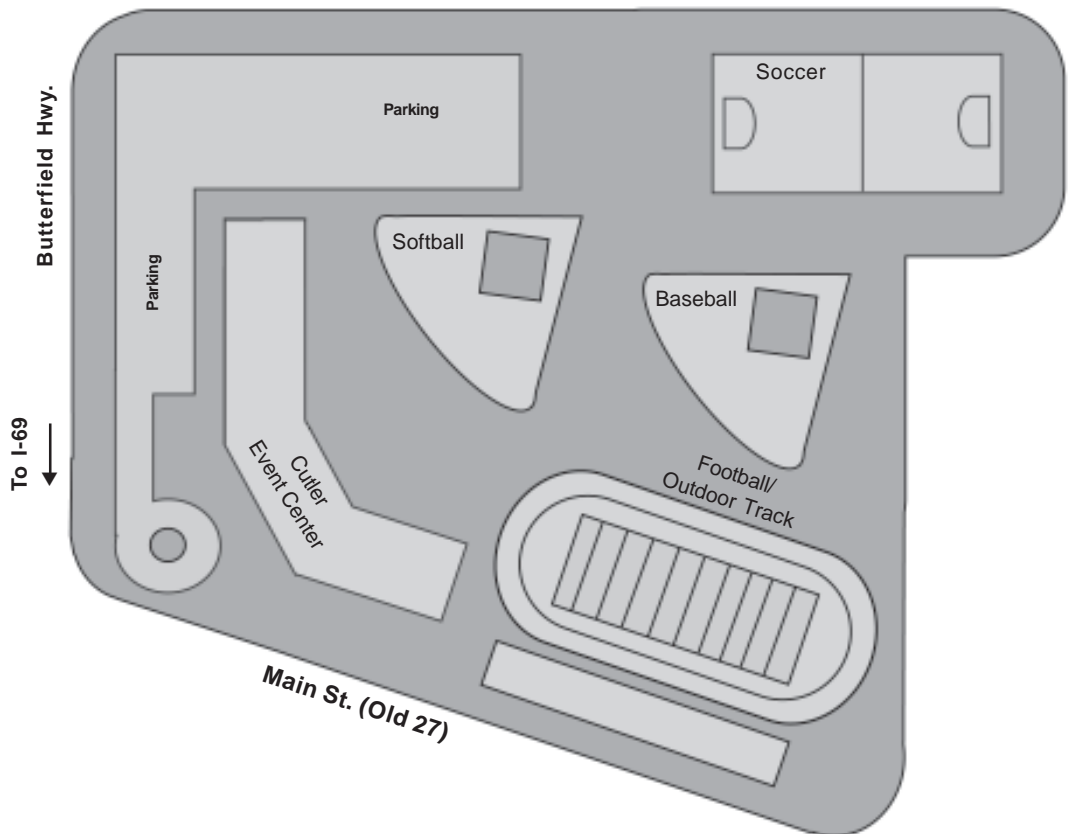
**From Lansing:** Take I-69 south to Exit 51 (Ainger Road). From the exit ramp turn left. Proceed until you reach the stop sign at Main St., about 1 mile. Turn right at the stop sign. If you are coming for a swimming and diving meet, turn left at Cottage St. (about 1/2 mile) and the Upton Center Pool is 1/4 mile on your right side. If you are coming for an outdoor sport, continue on Main St. and turn left onto Butterfield Hwy. and turn right into the Cutler Athletic Complex parking lot.

**From Chicago/Kalamazoo:** Take I-94 east to I-69 north. Follow I-69 north to exit 48. From the exit ramp turn right. Proceed until you reach the stop sign at Main St., about 1 mile. If you are coming for an outdoor sport, go straight at the stop sign. Proceed about 1/4 mile, turn right into the Cutler Athletic Complex parking lot. If you are coming for swimming and diving, turn left at the stop sign. Proceed and turn right onto Cottage St. (about 1/2 mile). The Upton Center Pool is located 1/4 mile on the right side.

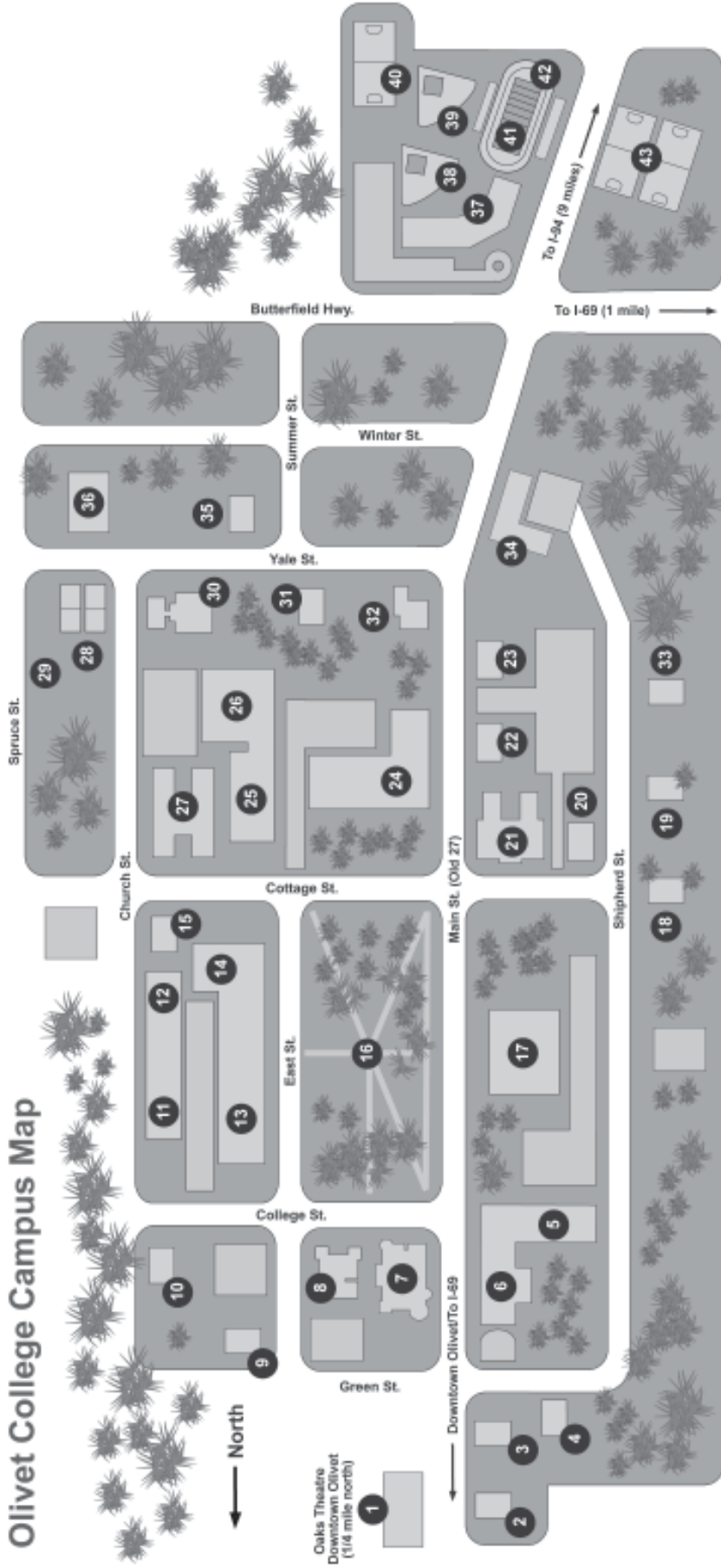
**From Mount Pleasant:** Take 127 south to I-69 west/south. Follow I-69 south to exit 51 (Ainger Road). From the exit ramp turn left. Proceed until you reach the stop sign at Main St., about 1 mile. Turn right at the stop sign. If you are coming for a swimming and diving meet, turn left at Cottage St. (about 1/2 mile) and the Upton Center Pool is 1/4 mile on your right side. If you are coming for an outdoor sport, continue on Main St. and turn left onto Butterfield Hwy. and make a right turn into the Cutler Athletic Complex parking lot.

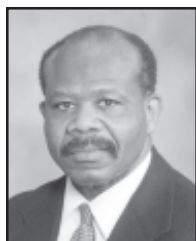
