

Position:

Conversational English & Specialty Teachers in China

Job description:

Teach conversational English skills to Chinese students (predominately middle & high school) who have had formal English reading and writing classes but need help adopting an American accent. Specialty teachers will teach in their academic disciplines, with some positions at the college level. Program uses graduates and alumni from any major during renewable 10 or 12-month terms. Round-trip airfare reimbursed by host school at completion of contract. Free housing, paid vacations, and the opportunity to learn Chinese at the same school where you teach English. Free TESL Training/Certification. Summer school programs available on a limited basis.

Qualifications:

Requires a bachelor's degree or above in any major, good public speaking skills with a standard American accent, flexibility and adaptability to foreign cultures and customs. Preference will be given to alumni with 2+ years work experience in any field. Valid passport required before employment contract can be negotiated with school.

Job duration:

10-12 months, renewable

Pay:

4,000 to 6,500 RMB/mo (equiv. to US\$4,000 plus all living expenses)
