



## Lifetime Giving

### **The Frederick and Margaret Upton Society**

The Upton Society is named in honor of Frederick and Margaret Upton and their family, through whose generosity the College has funded many programs as well as entire buildings. The society recognizes the dedication and generosity of all alumni and friends who have given \$1 million or more in outright gifts to the College, or those who have pledged to do so over a period of time.

### **The Barber, Benedict and Keyes 1863 Society**

The Barber, Benedict and Keyes 1863 Society is named in honor of the members of the first graduating class of the College, consisting solely of three women: Mary N. Barber, Sara Benedict and Sophia A. Keyes. The Society recognizes all donors who have given \$500,000 to \$999,999 in outright gifts to the College, or those who have pledged to do so within a period of up to 10 years.

### **The Oramel and Abby Hosford Society**

The Oramel and Abby Hosford Society honors the College's first faculty members, who spent their lives challenging the minds of the many students who strolled through the oaks of Olivet. The society recognizes all donors who have given \$250,000 to \$499,999 in cumulative giving to the College.

### **The Joseph Brewer Society**

The Joseph Brewer Society honors the 17<sup>th</sup> President of the College, who worked diligently not only to preserve the principles upon which Olivet was founded but to firmly establish the College as a fountainhead of social and academic excellence. The Society recognizes all donors who have given \$100,000 to \$249,999 in cumulative giving to the College.

### **The Hiram Archer Society**

The Hiram Archer Society is named to honor those visionary alumni and friends of Olivet College whose commitment reflects one of our key founding principles: to create a liberal arts college which is open to all students regardless of race, creed or gender. The society recognizes all donors who have given over a lifetime \$50,000 to \$99,999 in cumulative giving to the College.

## Annual Giving

### **The John and Esther Shipherd Society**

The John and Esther Shipherd Society honors the College's founders who, in 1844, stated simply that they wished "to do our students good, by placing in their hands the means of intellectual, moral and spiritual improvement, and to teach them the divine art and science of doing good to others." The society recognizes all donors who have given an annual gift of \$25,000 and up to the College.

### **The Cornerstone Society**

The Cornerstone Society honors those alumni and friends of the College who provided an indispensable foundation for the fulfillment of its mission. The society recognizes all donors who have given \$10,000 to \$24,999 in outright gifts to the College.

### **The Oaks Society**

The Oaks Society is named to honor those alumni and friends of Olivet College who have provided consistent support. The society recognizes the dedication and generosity of all those visionary alumni and friends who have given \$1,000 to \$9,999 in outright gifts annually to the College.

### **The President's Club**

The President's Club honors the tradition of outstanding leadership in the Olivet College Community. Members include alumni and friends whose gifts range between \$500 and \$999 annually.

### **The Founder's Club**

Providing a strong identity with the growth of Olivet College, membership in the Founder's club begins with gifts of \$250 and includes gifts from alumni and friends in a single year up to \$499.
