MINING ENGINEERING MAJORS ADD: CEM 152 (4), SCI 105 (3)

At least six credits of General Elective courses must come from social science, economics, government or history and at least six credits from art, music, literature, or philosophy. **Electrical, Environmental and Computer Engineering students should take 13 credits of General Electives.**

All recommended courses will transfer and apply towards degree requirements provided grades of "C-" (1.5 on a 4.0 scale) or better are earned. It is not required that students complete all recommended courses prior to enrolling at Michigan Tech. There are no minimum nor maximum credit restrictions in effect for transfer students. There is a residency requirement of one year for all students. Qualified students will be accepted any time they choose to apply regardless of the number of courses completed provided openings exist in their requested program.
