

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USING THE MAJOR REQUIREMENTS LISTS

1. The following pages are lists of required classes that will satisfy the major and minor you have chosen.
2. Each major page contains all of the required **general education requirements** in the left column and **major requirements** in the right column. The minor page has only the **minor requirements**. There is also a page of general education requirements alone and a page of Education classes for people who are triple minors in the education department. See the Teacher Preparation Advice page for instructions if you wish to be a public school teacher.
3. To the right of the class listed there are two columns. One tells when the class is offered (spring, fall or both) and how many semester hours the class is.
4. **It is important that you make a 4 year plan as soon as possible** so that you don't have to return for an extra semester for one class you were not aware that you had to take. These pages will help you when doing your four year plan. There are forms for this in the Portfolio folder in Public Folders.
5. In the **Creative Experience requirement** (which is a 3 semester hour requirement) there are some classes that are only 1 semester hour. You may take one class 3 times or take different classes in combination to add up to 3 sh.
6. Behind certain classes there are letters in bold type (**DW, SL & SE**). These classes satisfy the Diverse World, Service Learning and Senior Experience requirements. All students must take one class that satisfies each of these three requirements. Some majors have them built in and some do not, so you must find a class perhaps in another discipline or in your minor that will satisfy these requirements. Classes that satisfy these three requirements may be subject to change from year to year so be sure to check that you have the current list of these special classes. They can be found in the current course schedule books.
