Successfully completing these cognitive perspective courses will satisfy the College's Lab Science requirement for students who matriculated at Olivet College prior to the Fall of 1995.

- (3) PSY 390 (Research Methods) should be taken in the junior or senior year, after taking at least six semester hours of psychology courses.
