

Dates and times for Seasonal Flu Vaccine clinics in the Charlotte area.

Thursday, September 24	9 am – 4 pm	Charlotte Assembly of God Church 1100 E. Clinton Trail (across from Meijer)
Thursday, October 1	9 am – 4 pm	Charlotte Assembly of God Church 1100 E. Clinton Trail (across from Meijer)

The cost of the vaccine at the above clinics is \$32.00. Some insurance companies can be billed. Those insurances are:

Medicare, Medicaid, PHP commercial, Blue Cross/Blue Shield, and Priority Health (pre-authorization is needed).

The health department cannot bill Blue Care Network. Those with Blue Care Network will need to contact your own physician for a flu shot.

There will be a second flu vaccine for the novel H1N1 influenza virus. That vaccine will be available later in the fall. Please watch your e-mails regarding information on those upcoming dates.

Flu vaccine shots are also now available at the **Olivet office of Marshall Internal and Family Medicine (MIFM) at 202 N. Main**. Appointments can be made by calling (269) 749-2131. The cost of the flu shot at MIFM is \$35. You are welcome to call there with any questions.
