1. What is the Student Employment Program?

The Student Employment Program provides an opportunity to earn money and gain valuable work experience while attending college. Students also earn a monthly paycheck for the hours they work.

2. Why doesn't Olivet include Student Employment on the Financial Aid Award?

You must research, apply for and be hired into student employment positions before it is applied to your official Financial Aid Award package.

3. Can I use Student Employment to pay my bill?

Certainly! There are specific due dates before the start of each semester when you are required to either pay your bill in full, or have acceptable payment arrangements in place. If you are hired for a student employment position, you most likely won't begin working until after the semester has begun. However, once you begin working, you can apply your earnings toward your account for the next semester.

4. Why should I apply for a Student Employment position?

Being a student employee may be your first real-world working experience. The opportunity helps build references, which are important for your future internship and career goals. Finally, it allows you to earn money while attending college.

5. How do I apply for a Student Employment position?

On Aug. 1, 2017, available student employment positions are posted on the Olivet College website. You may apply for as many positions as you wish, but are limited to accepting no more than two positions.
