

# **SPRING 2019 AWARDS**

### **Merit Award**

A merit scholarship will be awarded according to high school or college GPA (whichever is higher).

## Mid Semester Achievement Scholarship\*

Mid Semester Achievement Scholarship recipients that showcase a cumulative GPA of at least a 3.0 from their transferring post-secondary institution or high school will be granted an additional \$1,000 for the Spring Semester in recognition of their academic accolades. (Nine credit hour minimum.)

## **Michigander Award**

If a student enrolling spring semester at Olivet College resides outside of Michigan, a Michigander Award will be added to their spring award package.

## Talent Scholarships\*

If eligible and nominated by a Talent Director, a Talent Scholarship will be added to the award package.

\*If a talent award is given and is more than the student's original award, it could replace other institutional aid given by the college, depending on the amount.

### **Mission Grant**

The Mission Grant will be awarded according to financial need based on FAFSA results.

#### **Be Here Grant**

If a student is leaving their current residence to move to Olivet College campus owned housing, they may qualify for \$500 in one-time grant aid in order to assist them in making the transition to living and learning on campus.
