- 6) **Method(s) used by the institution to determine Which Students receive** Emergency Financial Aid grants and How much they would receive under CRRSAA:
 - a. Initial student need was assessed by determining EFC, based on 2020 FAFSA or unpaid balance to the college that interfered with registration for summer 2021 term or fall 2021 semester.
 - b. Students were invited to submit an online CRRSAA Grant Form indicating additional needs in basic living expenses and technology and to add additional comments regarding their needs. A grants review committee reviewed student responses in which additional needs were identified and an awarding matrix determined.
 - c. Students eligible for the CRRSAA funding, defined as those students eligible for Federal Financial Aid (whether or not they accepted it), and who submitted a FAFSA and CRRSAA Grant form identifying an established or previously unaddressed need per the awarding matrix received funding.
